Biondi Santi is a renowned Tuscan producer known for its Brunello di Montalcino. Brunello di Montalcino owes its existence to Ferruccio Biondi-Santi. ### **Tasting Notes**

Produced from Sangiovese Grosso BBS11 vines of at least 25 years of age from Tenuta Greppo. Brilliant ruby red. Despite a tannic frame still perceptible, its fruit takes over with black pepper and spicy hints. This cuvée already gives us a lot of fun. A wine of future with a nice balance. Harmonic, it will grow slowly but surely. Very long-lasting persistence.
