THE ESTATE IS LOCATED IN NORTH OF THE MEDOC APPELLATION AT THE TOP OF THE HIGHEST HILL SURROUNDING THE SMALL VILLAGE OF VALEEYRAC, DOMINATING THE GIRONDE RIVER
