CANTINE FONTEZOPPA DOC VERDICCHIO DI MATELICA, 2014

BACKGROUND

FONTEZOPPA IS LOCATED BETWEEN THE TOWNS OF SERRAPETRONA AND SAN SEVERINO, CONSIDERED TO BE ONE OF THE BEST SPOTS TO GROW GRAPES IN THE MARCHE REGION. THE OWNER/WINE MAKER GIOVANNI BASSO, AFTER 20 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A GROWER, ALWAYS PRODUCES WINES OF TRADITIONAL CHARACTER THAT RESPECT THE TERRITORY. THE 25 YEAR OLD VINES GROW BETWEEN 500 -600 METERS ABOVE SEA LEVEL, VERY CLOSE TO THE ADRIATIC SEA, IN AN AREA THAT BENEFITS FROM THE COOL SEA BREEZE.

TASTING NOTES

DARK STRAW YELLOW, WITH GREENISH REFLECTIONS, CRYSTAL CLEAR WITH A GOOD CONSISTENCY, THE LEGS CONFIRM THE ALCOHOLIC AND GLYCEROL CONTENTS. ON THE NOSE THIS WINE HAS NOTES OF GOLDEN APPLES AND WALNUTS, JUNIPER AND JASMINE. NICELY SMOOTH AND FRESH ON THE PALATE, WELL POISED ALCOHOLIC CONTENT AND GOOD BODY. SAPID WALNUT PALATE.
