BACKGROUND

BARRABAQUE IS A SUBSTANTIAL CHATEAU UP ON THE HILL ABOVE FRONSAC OVERLOOKING THE RIVER DORDOGNE. ACHILLE NOEL ACQUIRED IT FROM THE CRABY FAMILY IN 1936.

TASTING NOTES

CHATEAU BARRABAQUE HAS AN INTENSE, FRUITY NOSE WITH A PREPODERANCE OF BLACKCURRANTS AND JAMMY DARK FRUIT AROMAS. THE ROBUST PALATE IS FULL OF MORE BLACKCURRANT, CHERRIES, A TOUCH OF VANILLA SPICE AND HAS GOOD SUPPLE TANNIN STRUCTURE.
