BACKGROUND

IN THE 1940'S, GIACINTO, RAFFAELE AND MARINA TOOK OVER THE BUSINESS THAT HAD BEEN SET UP AS FAR BACK AS 1863 BY GRANDFATHER GIACINTO, AND THEIR OWN FATHER, ANTONIO. A NEW WINERY NOW STANDS IN A HARMONIOUS BLEND OF TRADITION AND TECHNOLOGICAL PROGRESS. THE BROVIAS OWN GREAT VINEYARDS, SUCH AS ROCHE – WHICH HAS ALWAYS BEEN RENOWNED FOR ITS PRESTIGE – AND VILLERO, A VINEYARD IN THE HEART OF THE BAROLO GROWING AREAS OF HISTORIC IMPORTANCE. A NEW GENERATION OF BROVIAS HAS TAKEN TO THE WINE-MAKING TRADITION WITH SKILL AND ENTHUSIASM, LOOKING TO THE NEW CENTURY WITH THE CONFIDENCE THAT COMES FROM SUCH STRONG TIES WITH THE PAST AND BRIMMING WITH THE DESIRE TO CONTINUE TO IMPROVE. ROBERT PARKER CONSTANTLY REVIEWS BROVIA'S WINES WITH SCORES IN THE 90'S FOR THEIR BAROLO LINE.

TASTING NOTES

THE PARTICULAR COMPOSITION OF THE GROUND CONFERS ON THE WINE A GREAT BALANCE IN THE SCENT AND IN THE STRUCTURE. THE COLOUR IS INTENSE RED. THE SMELL IS HETEROGENEOUS, WITH A CLEAN SCENT OF DRY AND SWEET FRUIT AND FLORAL AROMAS. THE WINE IS FULL BODIED WITH A SOLID ACIDITY THAT GIVES IT MORE LONGEVITY SUITABLE TO STAND THE TEST OF TIME.
