

CHATEAU DE MIRANDE MACON VILLAGES BLANC, 2015

BACKGROUND

CHATEAU DE MIRANDE IS A PRIVATE DOMAINE LOCATED IN THE MÂCONNAIS REGION. IT IS ONE OF A VERY FEW PROPERTIES OF ITS SIZE DATING BACK TO THE 11TH CENTURY. DURING THE MIDDLE AGES, THE DOMAINE WAS CONSIDERED ONE OF THE OUTBUILDINGS OF THE RENOWN ABBEY DE CLUNY. PURCHASED AFTER THE FRENCH REVOLUTION BY THE L'EPINE FAMILY IT NOW COVERS SOME 62 ACRES, A THIRD CONTAINING VINES OVER 40 YEARS OLD. THE VINES ARE 100% CHARDONNAY. THEY GROW IN THE CLAY AND CHALK SOIL OF THE GENTLE HILLS WHICH BORDERING THE SAÔNE VALLEY BETWEEN THE VILLAGES OF LUGNY AND VIRÉ.

TASTING NOTES

HERE IS A MAÇON VILLAGES APPROACHABLE. THE AROMATIC RANGE SUGGESTS EXOTIC NOTES OF PINEAPPLE AND MANGO AND ACCOMPANIED BY AN EDGE FRESH GRASS. ON THE PALATE, THE WINE IS SOFT AND BALANCED AND OFFERS A TASTY FINISH.
